Acreage & Farm Safety

Program Description:

This interactive and hands-on program teaches students how to recognize potential dangers and avoid injury in an acreage or farm environment.

During a classroom story lesson, children learn to assess and safely navigate a number of realistic, potentially dangerous, scenarios. In the Safety Centre Barn children practice safety skills at interactive stations including animal awareness, ATV tipping, grain silos, chemical safety and many more.

They finish up their lesson outdoors on the land with playful and memorable games to ingrain the safety lessons they learned during the day.

Please note that while protected, some of the equipment showcased in this program can be dangerous – rowdy or misbehaving children will not be permitted to interact with stations in the barn for the safety of the whole group.

Be a Tree Animal Safety

Program Description:

Students will learn how domestic animals express themselves in natural ways, how to recognize signs of joy, playfulness, warnings, and aggression.

By studying the most expressive of dogs, students will learn to read and recognize body language, visual traits, and the messages that different vocalizations convey.

Knowing how happy and healthy animals react to human presence allows students to gain confidence around animals, and gives them the skills to recognize un-happy, erratic, or dangerous behaviors. They will also learn potentially life-saving techniques in response to an aggressive animal, acting to protect themselves and others in a safe and controlled environment.

*This program can be adapted to include other animal groups or wildlife in general – contact us for more information.**

A trained dog may be requested for this program, unknown or personal animals are not permitted for liability concerns and safety.

Fire & Home Safety

Program Description:

Do your children know the importance of a home escape plan or how to call 9-1-1? This program combines a classroom safety story with hands-on activities and a visit to Sparky's House. Students learn how fires start, how to spot and control common hazards in your home, how to create a home escape plan, and practice calling 9-1-1.

In Sparky's House the children take the role of inspector, writing up our usually diligent staff for the things they have left lying around before performing a daring escape through less-than-normal means of exiting your average family home in a sudden emergency scenario.

Please note that this program does involve a non-toxic smoke machine, children with severe asthma will be accommodated but our team must be made aware prior to the program.

Bike Safety & PedalPushers

Program Description:

Focusing on proper road safety procedures and safe equipment, this program builds on the basic skills of beginner and intermediate cyclists. Students will learn how to inspect and care for their bike and the most common problems with the hardware.

Once safe to ride the group will learn proper signalling and right-of-way, emergency stops, and how to adhere to traffic and pedestrian signals with your bike.

After completing their training they will work through a multi-stage testing course to demonstrate their safe riding habits – receiving a PedalPushers certification upon completion.

An added off-site adventure can be included with this program booking for an additional fee – *time permitting*.

All cyclists must provide their own bike and helmet.

Traffic & Pedestrian Safety

Program Description:

During our premiere field-trip program, students learn the basics of street safety using an interactive storyboard depicting a classical neighbourhood. Children learn to safely cross the street using the 7 *Steps-to-Safety*, the meaning of various road signs, and how to read a set of traffic lights.

Working outdoors in our CityStreetScape, students practice their newfound safety skills as both pedestrian and vehicle operators using our battery powered mini-quads, bikes, or adapted buggies.

All participants must bring their own fitted bicycle helmets.

Mini-quads are weight rated to 100lbs.

Class sizes are restricted to a maximum of 25 riders.

If opting to use bicycles participants must bring their own bikes, scooters, skateboards, or roller skates.

Birthday Parties:

In a Safety City birthday party children will learn road and vehicle safety before heading out to roam around the CityScape using battery-powered mini-quads, visiting the locals within and discovering fun challenges.

Group access to the party room is included with your rental.

All kids go home with a safety goodie bag and the birthday child receives an upgraded version in their very own backpack!

Parties are limited to 15 kids total.

All riders must bring their own helmets.

Note:

Parties are 3 hours in duration with 1.5-2.0 hours of instruction with a safety educator included. This time includes a brief instruction period regarding the quad's operation and rules of the road (stop signs, following arrows, etc) followed by lots of fun riding the quads around the CityScape. Inside time for cake and presents can occur dynamically throughout the party time.

You are welcome to come 15 minutes early to decorate the classroom however you'd like/set up food/presents/cake. We also have a fridge and freezer for any cold food or drinks you have

Alcoholic drinks are not permitted within the premises.

Weather issues/concerns will be rescheduled free of charge.

Indoor activities are available in surprise circumstances.
